QUICK START GUIDE

WELCOME TO WYZE

Thanks for getting your hands on a Wyze Sprinkler. If this is your first Wyze product, welcome to the Wyze family! Whether you bought this to start an elaborate garden or to just keep the lawn green, you have made a good choice. Let's get started by setting up your Wyze Sprinkler.

IN THE BOX Wyze Sprinkler × 1

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

Drill 7/32 Drill Bit Hammer (for drywall anchor) An irrigation system (Wyze Sprinkler replaces your old controller but relies on your existing irrigation system)

SETUP

Download the Wyze app and sign in or create an account.



Den the Wyze app. Select Wyze Sprinkler from the Add Device screen. Follow the instructions in the Wyze app to complete setup.

WARNING/CAUTION

Do NOT install device in a location that will be exposed to the elements. It is intended for indoor use only.

Do NOT use device with index valves.

Always unplug device from power before adjusting any wires after installation. Never touch live wires. Harmful or fatal electric shock may result.

Ensure that all wiring complies with local building codes. Do not connect more than one value to a terminal or two devices together. Doing so may result in damage to the device(s).

FAQ

Do I need to have Sprinkler Plus?

No. Sprinkler Plus is an optional service that adds a ton of smarts to your system. With Sprinkler Plus you can create Smart Schedules, enable Weather Skips, and view detailed Zone Moisture information.

How does Sprinkler Plus decide when to water?

Sprinkler Plus uses the previous and forecasted weather to calculate the water balance of each zone. When the water balance gets too low, we'll schedule a watering. You can learn more at wyze.com

What happens if the device goes offline?

Wyze Sprinkler will continue watering based on your normal schedule for the next 14 days if it loses connection to the internet. After that, we'll fall back to the Offline Schedule, which you can customize in Settings.

How do I edit my zone parameters?

For the best experience, make sure each zone is configured correctly. Go into each zone's Settings page and check that you have the correct soil type, crop type, spray head, etc. selected. Some of these settings have advanced settings associated with them, so feel free to dig deeper if you really want to get in the weeds (pun intended).

Can I use my existing soil and rain sensors?

Wyze Sprinkler works with many brands of sensors. Visit Wyze.com for details and wiring instructions.

BASIC OPERATIONS

Water a specific zone

Press the forward and back arrows to select the desired zone, then press the water droplet button to begin watering.

Stop a current watering

Press the stop watering button.
